Future Plans :

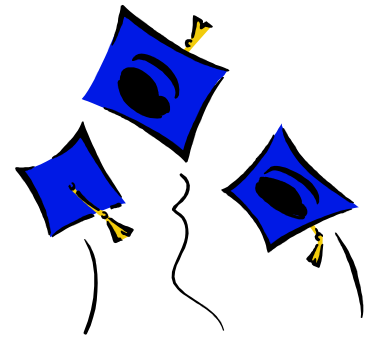
Attending the Chef's Academy and finding a job.
